

But you can 5 actually do -- you can actually look in -- look at domains 6 and see if they become available. 7 Okay. So -- but that's a wait list. That's not 8 actually the domain name itself; right? 9 Α. No. You can't -- there's -- can only be one 10 register or owner register of a domain name at a time. 11
  - Q. Okay. And at the time in 2004, from February 2004 to I guess it was April of 2005, whatever the date is, you were that owner?
    - A. Yes.
