KAM Licenses Train Track™ Software for Model Railroad Enthusiasts "Why Play With Toys When You Can Use the Prototype" SM

Kansas City, MO. July 24, 1998 – KAM Industries announced today that they have received an exclusive, worldwide license for Train Track's TDPro software for the model railroad market. The TDPro software is used to provide train control, goods management and distribution of rolling stock assets in over 20 class 1 railroads. KAM will convert the world class Train Track software for use by the model railroad enthusiast and combine it with KAM's patent-pending Train Server® technology.

KAM will introduce their product based on the TDPro software in Q1'99 as part of KAM's Computer Dispatcher® product line. At that time, the Computer Dispatcher core product is expected to be priced at \$249 per single user / single CPU copy and will include not only the core product but the track layout design as well. Optional modules are expected to be priced at \$99 each. These will include historical playback of layout events; direct train control for dark area management (areas without CTC control); track warrant issue and management; train sheet / rolling stock distribution; train usage management; and, train simulation / trainer. Then current users of Engine Commander® products will be able to upgrade to the new product line at a discounted rate.

"We are very excited about this venture", said Kevin Hassett, President of Train Track Computer Systems, Inc. "This is a first for the industry. It opens up many avenues of software advancement that will benefit both the railroad

industry and the hobbyist market as well".

"KAM is very happy to be able to provide the hobbyist with the same software that controls major railroads such as the Burlington Northern and Norfolk Southern", said Matthew Katzer, Partner at KAM Industries. "The Prototype modeler has been waiting for these features for a long time".
